Description:

The JAG Program replaced the Edward J. Byrne Memorial Formula (Byrne) Grant and the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG) Programs in 2005 to create a single funding mechanism that would simplify the administration process for grantees. JAG supports local law enforcement, including multi-jurisdictional drug and gang task forces, domestic violence and child abuse investigators, DARE and School Resource Officers, drug courts, corrections, treatment, victim services, information sharing/technology, and other prevention initiatives that strengthen the nation's criminal justice system.


